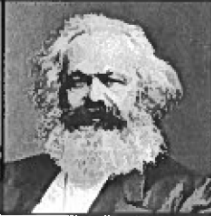

Record a minimum of 3 traits (in-text citation required) along with the Russian counterpart. You can annotate right in your book, or I have included an organizer if you would like to record your findings.

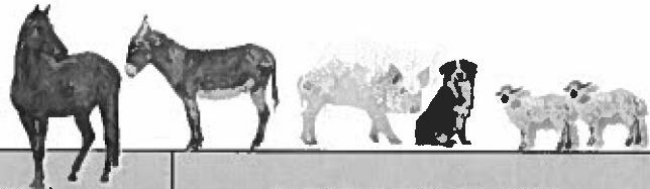
