Welcome! This is going to be an exciting year! I am praying for you as you prepare to come to Pre-Kindergarten. Our first day of school is September 5th at 8:15, dismissing at 12:00 for full day students enrolled for Wednesday classes. This year please bring a healthy snack but refrain from bringing in any food that contains nuts as we are a nut free classroom. I am looking forward to seeing you soon. For your convenience I have included a list of supplies that you will need for the upcoming school year. Please make sure you have everything labeled with your name on it.

- ◇ An extra complete set of clothes in a *Ziploc* bag, labeled with your name
- ◇ All-day students need to bring a small travel-size pillow, a beach towel and a small blanket or a toddler nap mat (teacher recommended)
- ◇ One four-can set of *Play-doh* (*Play-doh* brand, please)
- ◇ 2 boxes of tissues
- ◇ 3 containers of anti-bacterial wipes in pop-up container, please no baby wipes
- ◇ \$10.00 cash for school supplies purchased throughout the year
- ◇ 1 laminated placemat
- ◇ Regular sized backpack
- ◇ 1 red plastic pocket folder
- ◇ 1 package Expo dry erase markers and dry erase eraser
- ◇ 1 box 8-12 jumbo/primary crayons
- ◇ 8-12 fat/primary pencils
- ◇ 1 plastic pencil box
- ◇ Non-Disposable water bottle

Please bring a healthy snack for the mornings (no fruit cups or yogurt cups.) Full day students need to bring a lunch, or purchase lunch online from our lunch catering provider. If you are staying for After-Care, you will need an additional snack for after school.
