Dear Parents of Upper School Students:

I trust that you and your family are enjoying your summer. We continue to stay busy at school eagerly preparing for our students' return in the Fall. We are looking forward to our best year yet!

Your 6th-12th grade children will need the following items to start school on *Tuesday September 6, 2022*, which is a half day dismissing at 12:00:

- New International Version (NIV) Study Bible (labeled with name)
- Blue or black, red and green ink pens
- Pencils (#2)
- Highlighters (any colors) Recommended: 3 different colors
- Loose-leaf notebook paper (no spiral notebooks)
- One 1 ½ inch flexible 3-ring binder
- Approximately (3) pocket folders with holes (for placement in binder)
- 2 large boxes of tissues to give to the homeroom teacher for class use
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- Book Covers: please cover textbooks preferably with brown paper bags; only purchase 5 <u>JUMBO</u> book sox if absolutely necessary (small sizes not permitted as they damage books/bindings). <u>All</u> text books must be covered!
- Calculator (wait to purchase until teacher explains what type is needed for the class you are taking)
- Pre- Algebra, Algebra 1 and Algebra 2 need graph filler paper

Please note that this list is not exhaustive and *teachers may request additional supplies for specific classroom needs* during the first weeks of school.

Students will receive their books, lockers, schedules and laptops (if applicable) on the first day of school. This is when students will finalize and resolve any schedule issues as well. The Uniform Exchange table will be available at least the week prior to the start of school if not sooner for your convenience. There will also be a New Student Orientation on Thur Sept. 1 at 12:00-1:00 in the Joy Center.
