Our middle school athletics also had a successful season, with both soccer teams having a record of 5-1-1. Some of these games were co-ed, such as their tie against Faith Christian.

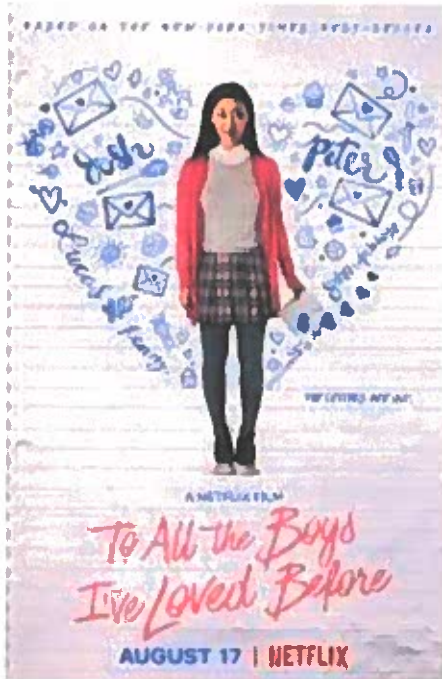
Volleyball

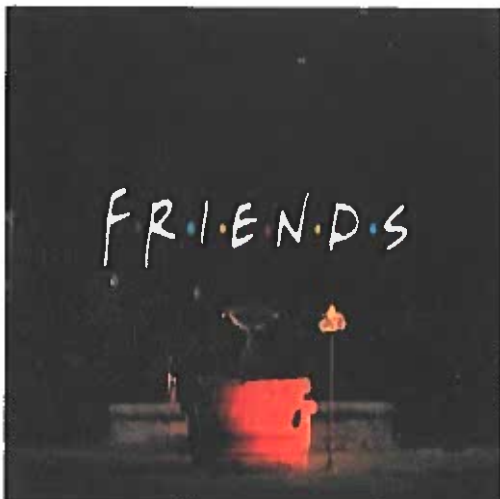


To All The Boys I've Loved Before (2018)
